How To Reach Damdama College

Damdama College is easily accessible via NH-37. Buses, taxis and private cabs ply between the nearest city center at Jalukbari to the college and beyond. Those reaching Guwahati Railways can get down at the Kamakhya railway junction, which is at a distance of about 15 km from the college. From the station, it is easy to board a taxi or auto rickshaw to reach Jalukbari or even use the same transport to reach the College. It should take about forty to forty-five minutes. Those opting for air travel can reach the Lokapriya Gopinath Bordoloi International airport at Borjhar which is about 31 km from the college. Private taxis like Ola, or Uber are available here. It takes about fifteen to twenty minutes to reach Jalukbari from where one needs to take the NH-37. From Jalukbari, one has to cross the new Brahmaputra Bridge and take the nearest left turn to Nalbari Hajo Road. From there, it is straight to Damdama via other stops like Amingaon, Dadara, Singimari and Sessa.
